

Thank you for the opportunity to review Florida State University's Real Estate program. After a complete comparison of the Florida State University program and the Appraisal Qualifications Board (AQB) Education Matrix I am happy to say that the Florida State University program meets the pre-license education requirements for both the certified residential and certified general appraiser license. The only addition would be that the student must complete the 15 hour National USPAP Course and the three hour Roles and Rules for Supervisors and Trainee Appraisers as required by the Florida Administrative Code.

The Division of Real Estate would like to review the Florida State University program every two years to ensure the continued compliance with the Appraisal Qualifications Board guidelines. Should there be any change in the Florida State University Real Estate program please notify the Division so that we may ensure continued compliance.
