The Angus Robinson, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Foundation is a non-profit education fund established in the memory of Angus Robinson, Jr., who was in the reinsurance industry for nearly 20 years. The Foundation awards scholarships to students of Risk Management, Insurance or Actuarial Science.

The goals of the foundation are outlined in the attached fact sheet. In order to qualify for a scholarship, students must comply with all phases of the application process.

The essay should be limited to 500 words, and specifically address what the scholarship means to the applicant, what area of insurance they hope to pursue, and why they are interested in a career in the insurance industry.

Students must submit their application no later than December 11, 2008 either to the above address or to The Angus Robinson, Jr. Memorial Foundation, c/o Jackie Hayes, Odyssey America Reinsurance Corporation, 300 First Stamford Place, Stamford, CT 06902. The Trustees will make an announcement regarding the recipients by January 9, 2009.

We ask that you only submit your best candidates to the Foundation. We are looking for dedicated individuals who are in need of additional funds in order to complete their studies. Due to the overwhelming number of applications we receive, we are limiting the number of applicants from each academic institution to six. We would appreciate your compliance with these guidelines.

The Angus Robinson Jr. Memorial Foundation was founded in 1990 by friends and associates of the late Angus Robinson; who are involved in the insurance industry. Scholarship awards of up to \$5,000 per applicant will be made to qualified students who are enrolled in an insurance, risk management or actuarial science four-year degree program.

Required Application Documents:

1. A completed Scholarship Application and Financial Aid Form (attached) must be submitted along with Financial Aid and Academic Transcripts from your school.
2. A 500 word (double spaced typed) personal statement/essay on what the scholarship means to you, why you are interested in a career in the insurance industry and what specific field within the industry you hope to pursue.
3. Two references/recommendations from a Professor or employer.

Student Eligibility:

All students considered for the Angus Robinson, Jr. Memorial Foundation Scholarship must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Maintain a B average in Secondary School with a minimum SAT combined math and verbal scores of 1050, or

Maintain a 2.75 grade point average based on a scale of 4.0 for each year of college level education.
2. Maintain 12 credit hours of study per semester of college level education.
3. Must have a current Needs Analysis document on file with a Financial Aid Officer.

Selection Process:

Recipients will be selected by the Trustees of the Angus Robinson Jr. Memorial Foundation based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

1. Relative degree of financial need.
2. Cumulative GPA or SAT scores.
3. Content of personal statement/essay.
4. Strength of recommendations.
5. Demonstrated commitment to the pursuit of a career in the insurance industry.

Distribution of Funds:

The Angus Robinson, Jr. Memorial Foundation will forward a co-payable check to be credited to the student's College account.

At the time of the distribution verification will be made that the student is enrolled and in good academic standing.

In the case of a student withdrawing from College, the remaining scholarship monies must be returned to the Angus Robinson Jr. Memorial Foundation.
